The Master's English language entrance exam evaluates a candidate's proficiency in academic English by testing listening, reading and writing skills. The level of difficulty of tasks corresponds to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages level B2.

Admission requirement: a score of 75% or higher

Duration of the exam is **90 minutes,** the exam can be taken only once.

The entrance exam includes the following tasks:

1) **listening comprehension** - you will be listening to a short speech/interview. Based on the speech/interview you will have to answer multiple choice questions and/or decide whether the given statements are true or false. You will hear the recording twice.

2) **reading comprehension** – you will be reading a(n) text/article of about 800-900 words. Based on the text /article will have to answer multiple choice questions, complete the given sentences and/or decide whether the given statements are true or false.

3) **writing a summary** of about 400-440 words on the article in reading comprehension – The response will be graded on the quality of your writing, this includes the accuracy of content, logical presentation of key ideas using paraphrasing, clarity, readability and grammatical correctness.
